These instructions describe the commissioning (initial setup) and registration of the eAlarmApp Connect 4.0, which is compatible with the current iOS versions, and provide information about the available settings and their effects.





This setting allows the app to send notifications with sound even when the iPhone is set to silent mode.




### 3 Registering the eAlarmApp connect 4.0 with eAlarm emergency

| <p>First, you need to enter your mobile number, if it has not already been saved.</p> <p>Click on <b>"Registration"</b> and tap the field <b>"My number"</b> to open the input field.</p> <p>Now enter your mobile number. You can either enter the **received code** directly into the field (red arrow) or select the code in the app (marked in red). It will then be automatically transferred into the designated field, and the registration will be completed.






The eAlarmApp is now **successfully registered** with eAlarm emergency, and you are on the page where you can **adjust your settings**.

The message “**Not registered**” in the registration status has disappeared. The red status light is also no longer displayed. This means the app is **now registered, active, and ready to receive notifications**.



### Removing the Registration

The app's registration can also be removed.

To do this, select **“Registration status”** and then **“Delete registration.”**



**IMPORTANT:** Make sure that the app shows **“Not registered”** before you:

- uninstall the eAlarm App,
- remove your SIM card and intend to use it elsewhere, or
- switch off your iPhone and turn on another device using the same number (Multi SIM).

If you do not do this, eAlarm emergency will continue to assume the last set mode for your target number. As a result, you will either receive all messages with a **30-second delay** (fallback SMS in Active mode) or **no messages at all** (Inactive mode).



## 4 Changing the App Mode

The eAlarm App distinguishes between two app modes:





You must then open the app manually; once opened, it will connect to the server and transfer the alarm and information messages.</p> <p>If there is no data connection to the server at the time of the alarm or information message, a fallback to SMS will occur after 30 seconds, depending on the settings selected in your eAlarm emergency account.</p> |
| <p><b>Inactive</b></p>                                       | <p>In Inactive mode, the eAlarm App logs off from <b>eAlarm emergency</b>, and the participant is set to <b>“Absent.”</b></p> <p>This means the participant <b>cannot be alerted (not available)</b> in <b>eAlarm emergency</b>.</p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                |

**Important:** If the eAlarm App is closed via task management while in the Active status, alarm and information messages will still be delivered to the app, because Push Notifications will automatically reactivate it.

If you do not want alarm or information messages to be sent to the eAlarm App, you **must manually set the app mode to Inactive**. Instructions on how to set the app to Inactive mode are provided below.

### Log File in the Subscriber zone in eAlarm emergency

A **log file** is available in the **Subscriber zone**.  
The following statuses are included in the log file:

- **Registration of App Deleted:**  
The app registration has been deleted.
- **Registration Code Requested:**  
A registration code has been requested.
- **AppON Active:**  
The eAlarmApp currently has an active TCP connection to the server.
- **AppON Active – Disconnected:**  
The eAlarmApp currently has no active TCP connection to the server.
- **Push Sent to Mobile Device:**  
A push notification has just been sent to the eAlarmApp, thereby activating the app.  
The app connects to the server and retrieves any available alarm or information messages.
- **Alarm Delivered:**  
The alarm has been delivered to the eAlarmApp.
- **Information Message Delivered:**  
The information message has been delivered to the eAlarmApp.
- **AppOFF:**  
The app mode is set to *Inactive* — in this status, no messages (alarms or information) are sent to the participant.
- **Active Profile: Active**  
Displays the currently active profile.




**IMPORTANT:** If the eAlarmApp is deleted, all messages will also be deleted and cannot be recovered.



### Apple Critical Alerts (Critical Warning Notifications)

Apple Critical Alerts are special system notifications in iOS, iPadOS and watchOS designed for time-critical and safety-relevant events. They are deliberately distinguished from normal notifications to ensure that important alerts reach the user immediately.

#### Characteristics

- **Bypass Silent Mode:** Critical Alerts are displayed and played audibly even when:
  - the device is set to silent
  - Do Not Disturb or Focus mode is enabled
- **Audible Alert Signal:** A clearly audible alarm tone is played.
- **High Priority:** The notification appears immediately on the screen and overlays other content.
- **Limited Use:** Only apps approved by Apple are permitted to send Critical Alerts.

#### Purpose


1. Critical Alerts serve to provide immediate information in cases of danger or urgent need for action, for example:
  - medical emergencies
  - safety-related system conditions
  - environmental or hazard warnings

#### User control

- Users can enable or disable Critical Alerts **per app**.
- The setting is available in the system settings under **Notifications** for the respective app.
- Even when Critical Alerts are enabled, normal **notification controls** (banner, lock screen, notification centre) remain in place.

#### Restrictions

- Critical Alerts **must not be used for general information or marketing purposes**.
- Misuse will result in the withdrawal of authorisation by Apple.
- The feature is only available on supported Apple devices and operating system versions.



### Unread Messages (Badge)


**Unread and unacknowledged messages** are displayed on the home screen with a badge (1).

*Within the app itself, unread messages are also marked with badges so that they can be easily recognised.*

*When the eAlarmApp is opened, unread messages are automatically displayed to the user.*

### Menu "Unread"

The alarm notification is stored in the **Unread menu** item and can be managed directly from there.






### Displaying and Acknowledging the Alarm Notification

When the app is opened, the new alarm notification is displayed immediately.

This notification can be acknowledged.

### Acknowledge Alarm Notification


Example options: "Yes, I'm coming" or "No, I'm not coming".



After acknowledgement, the alarm notification is moved to the **History** menu.

In the **History** menu, depending on the settings, between **10 and a maximum of 50 notifications** can be stored – following the first in, first out principle.





### Deleting Messages


Messages can be deleted in the History menu. There are two ways to do this:





1. Swipe from right to left in the message overview.
2. Open the message – a delete button appears at the bottom of the screen.








## 7 Information Dispatch (= Info SMS)

The processing of **Info SMS messages** is identical to the handling procedure described for alarm messages.

Just like an alarm, an Info message (Info SMS) can include attachments sent via the eAlarm App (e.g. search photos).

The same file formats are supported as for alarm notifications:

- PDF
- DOCX, XLSX, PPTX
- JPG, GIF, PNG

As with alarm notifications, attachments are indicated by a paperclip icon.

Difference from alarm messages: For information messages, the **transmission of coordinate attachments is not supported**.

### General Notes

- All messages stored in the folders are encrypted.

## 8 Ports Used for Apple

To ensure proper communication between Apple services and the app (Push), and also between the app and the eAlarm system, the following ports must be open for connectivity:

- TCP Port 5223: Communication with APNs (Apple Push Notification service)
- TCP Port 2195: Transmission of notifications to APNs
- TCP Port 2196: APNs feedback service
- TCP Port 443: For device activation and fallback communication (especially on Wi-Fi), when devices cannot connect via port 5223
- TCP Ports 10100–10119: For communication between the app and the eAlarm server
